

Level 6 Registered Nurse Degree Apprenticeship.

From this apprenticeship, you will learn how to work in a range of care settings and effectively within a multidisciplinary team. You will develop the capabilities to care for individuals with complex care needs, in addition to assessing, planning, implementing and evaluating care. Effective communication in a range of situations will become a key part of your skillset, along with the essentials of medicines management.

To apply for this programme you must be employed in a relevant role, and as a minimum requirement have achieved one of the following:

Set by individual employers, but typically includes:

- Five GCSEs Inc Maths and English grade A-C (9-4 on the new grading system)
- A Higher Education Certificate in Health and Social Care or equivalent with care experience

If you are a non-native user of English, you must provide evidence of:

- Instruction and assessment predominantly in English throughout education; or
- A recent IELTS or equivalent score of 6.5 overall, with a minimum of 6.5 for each component; or
- HSSC 70%+
